

Care & Cleaning Instructions- Chairs



Chairs from Sandler Seating are designed for years of use by our customers. Basic care and cleaning will help to extend the life of your chair. Our suggestions for care & cleaning are as follows:

- Wood surfaces should be periodically wiped clean with a slightly damp cloth and a mild detergent diluted with water, followed immediately with a dry cloth to remove any moisture. Any spills should be wiped up immediately to avoid damage to the wood.
- Metal surfaces should be kept clean using the same procedures as above. Chrome plated surfaces can be cleaned with an ammonia-based solution such as Windex when needed, as long as it does not come in contact with other materials on the chair and it is quickly wiped clean.
- Upholstered surfaces should be cleaned according to the fabric supplier's suggestions.

- Nylon glides should be replaced as they begin to show wear, before the metal tubing of the chair legs can come in contact with the floor.
- Chair frames should be inspected periodically to look for excessive wear, and weld points should be inspected to assure there are no weld breaks.
- Unless otherwise noted, Sandler chairs are intended for indoors use only, and proper climate controlled environment is necessary to maintain consistent temperature and humidity. Exposure to direct sunlight should be avoided.
